Assist Bayside Presbyterian Church with the preparation and serving of meals for the Homeless of our community through Winter Watch of the Lighthouse Foundation

Provide Christmas gifts for 20+ families and individuals referred to us by the Department of Human Services: Mental Retardation/Developmental Disabilities, Social Services; Seton House, The Mission of the Holy Spirit, and In-House Families
- **Norfolk Jaycees Children's Project**  
Monetary donation to enable children in need to shop with Norfolk Jaycees for the purpose of buying Christmas gifts for their parents and family members

- **Tucker House Project**  
An on-going relationship with the residents of Tucker House in conjunction with the Youth of All Saints'

**February**

- **Food Pantry Month**  
Drive to replenish the staples in our Florence Slifer Food Pantry
- **Canterbury Center**  
February 10-2010 sharing of the Eucharist with and the provision of lunch for the Episcopal community at Old Dominion University

**March**

## Ongoing Weekly/Monthly/Quarterly Support

- **First Week – Food Pantry**  
Respond to the needs of one or two families referred to us by the Department of Social Services
- **Third Week – Full Circle Meals**  
Prepare and deliver 80-90 meals to individuals infected with AIDS through ACCESS
- **All Month – Mission of the Holy Spirit**  
Provide supplies for the personal needs of the adolescent girls at the Mission
- **Prayer Shawls**  
An on-going ministry of knitting and delivering, through Segar, prayer shawls and lap robes to the sick and shut-in members of our parish
- **Magazine Collection**  
Collect and deliver magazines to Seaman's House in Norfolk
- **Vroom...Vroom...**  
Provide an in-reach service that provides transportation to and from medical appointments and church activities for those within the parish
- **WC Drivers**  
Provide Sunday morning transportation to and from church to those in residence at Westminster-Canterbury
- **All Saints' Day School**  
Serve as the Commission sponsor liaison to the Vestry for the All Saints' Day School; a September through May half-day preschool and kindergarten program for 80+/- student in our community
- **Children First**  
Provide for the needs of children entering into the custody of Social Services and being placed in foster homes
- **Campbells' Label Drive**  
Collect and deliver Campbells' Labels to The Boys' Home in Covington, VA to supplement the purchase of instructional supplies
- **Pennies From Heaven**  
Collect small change and other donations to help offset the cost of prescription medications for those in transition to services from Medicaid
